


## Writing a Sequel to a Story

As a group, or on your own, take a story you know and imagining and writing a sequel (a story that happened after the original one ended.)

Now plan your sequel to the story. Think about your characters and how they will interact.

Think about settings. Write a few notes to yourself.

Introduction: What will be happening

when the story begins?

Plot: What happens? Dilemma? Resolution? Conclusion? Reflection?

Now type up your story. Don't forget to check your spelling and grammar. Use the Thesaurus to find better words for what you want to say.

Why not insert clipart?

Design a book front cover. Is it colourful and eye-catching? Would it make you want to read the story?

Write a brief synopsis for your new book. Write an author biography about yourself.

Present your new novel to the world!

## What About a Prequel?

Why not write a prequel to a story? Imagine what came BEFORE an original story started.
