

Use the writing frames below to finish a story. Sometimes, you have been given a starting paragraph and, sometimes, a conclusion.


It was the end of October. Halloween was close. We were all very excited.

I opened the book and scanned the words that were written there. Could it be true?







I heard the voice before I saw the person.





As I walked along the woodland path, a poem sprang into my mind, about the things I could see.

I stepped through the strange little door in the cupboard and found myself in the most amazing landscape I had ever seen.










Autumn was in the air. The leaves were beginning to change colour and fall from the trees.














**The season of Yule was upon us. People gathered the holly, ivy and yew branches that would provide somewhere for the spirits of the woodland to survive the bitter winter.**
