


Digit the Badger 10



It's puzzle time folks! Can you work out the answers to these wildlife puzzles?

There are some cattle in a field. 16 more come into the field. I can now see 67. How many were there to start with? (Badgers like fields of cows. They do lots of poos, and the badgers like to root underneath them for invertebrates. Lovely!)



The wood in which the badgers live is a perfect square. Its perimeter is 240 metres. How long is each side of the wood?



The badger group went out for a walk. They *walked* for 2 hours and 40 minutes. The group stopped for 10 minutes to watch some jays feed, 15 minutes sitting quietly to let some roe deer feed and cross in front of them without scaring them, and spent 35 minutes eating lunch. How long does their walk take them in total?

There are 12 pairs of woodpigeons in the wood. How many woodpigeons altogether?

Half the pairs have two chicks, the other half have one chick. How many pigeons and chicks altogether?

There are half as many great tit chicks as pigeon chicks. How many great tit chicks are there?



A spider has made a web near to the badger sett. It has 8 legs, (as all arachnids do.)

How many legs have 7 spiders?

How many legs have 15 spiders?
